

RESOLUTION NO. 55-2008

**BOROUGH OF RIVERDALE
COUNTY OF MORRIS
NEW JERSEY**

WHEREAS, impaired drivers on our nation's roads kill someone every 30 minutes, 50 people per day, and almost 18,000 people each year; and

WHEREAS, 28% of motor vehicle fatalities in New Jersey are alcoholic-related; and

WHEREAS, an enforcement crackdown is planned to combat impaired driving; and

WHEREAS, the end of summer season is traditionally a time of social gatherings which often include alcohol; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey, Division of Highway Traffic Safety, has asked law enforcement agencies throughout the state to participate in the *Over the Limit under Arrest 2008 Statewide Crackdown*; and

WHEREAS, the project will involve increased impaired driving enforcement from August 15 through September 1, 2008; and

WHEREAS, an increase in impaired driving enforcement and a reduction in impaired driving will save lives on our roadways.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Riverdale hereby declares it's support for the *Over the Limit Under Arrest 2008 Statewide Crackdown* from August 15 through September 1, 2008 and pledges to increase awareness of the dangers of drinking and driving.
