

RESOLUTION NO. 42-2010

WHEREAS, impaired drivers on our nation's roads kill someone every 30 minutes, 50 people per day, and almost 18,000 people each year; and

WHEREAS, 31% of motor vehicle fatalities in New Jersey are alcohol-related; and

WHEREAS, an enforcement crackdown is planned to combat impaired driving; and

WHEREAS, the summer season and the Labor Day holiday in particular are traditionally times of social gatherings which include alcohol; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey, Division of Highway Traffic Safety, has asked law enforcement agencies throughout the state to participate in the *Over the Limit Under Arrest 2010 Statewide Crackdown*; and

WHEREAS, the project will involve increased impaired driving enforcement from August 20 through September 6, 2010; and

WHEREAS, an increase in impaired driving enforcement and a reduction in impaired driving enforcement and a reduction in impaired driving will save lives on our roadways;

THEREFORE, be it resolved the Riverdale Borough declares its support for the *Over the Limit Under Arrest 2010 Statewide Crackdown* from August 20 through September 6, 2010 and pledges to increase awareness of the dangers of drinking and driving.
