Volunteers are an integral part of hosting a food pantry

They will serve as:

Sorters: Volunteers will sort donated food and place them on appropriate shelves in the pantry. Dated items will not be accepted and will be set aside to be delivered to selected food banks.

Baggers: Volunteers will be given a family number and a grocery list to fill. When completed, the numbered bags will be placed on “holding shelves” for pickup by a family member.

Monitors: Volunteers will serve as monitors on food pickup day. Each family member will sign in to pick their numbered bags. The monitor will also track any supermarket food card given out.

How many hours each week will you be willing to commit towards helping your neighbors?

Volunteers will be asked to sign on for up to one year to the weekly schedule to which they have committed. This will assure stability and continuity of service to the food pantry.
