On May 24th, the Pompton Lakes Riverdale First Aid Squad took delivery of two 2007 Horton ambulances. These ambulances are built on Ford E450 chassis. The old vehicles were traded in, with

about 40,000 miles each. The ambulances cost approx \$150,000 each, and are owned and purchased solely by the First Aid Squad. Money is raised from the generous donations of residents from Pompton Lakes and Riverdale. We alternate the use of the ambulances each day. Rig 26 is used on even days, Rig 27 is used on odd days. This keeps the mileage and maintenance costs equal. The equipment on one ambulance can be found in the same location on the other. They are equipped with radio communications that allow us to communicate with all the area towns and hospitals. The ambulances are used to respond to the 1100 calls we take annually. WalMart donated \$60,000 towards the purchase of one of these ambulances.

SUN SAFETY - HOW TO PROTECT YOUR CHILD FROM THE SUN

With the proper precautions, your children can play safely in the sun.

Here are some effective strategies:

Avoid the strongest rays of the day. This is 10:00 AM until 4:00 PM. If your child is in the sun between these hours, be sure to apply protective sunscreen, even if they are just playing in the backyard. Most sun damage occurs during day-to-day activities, not at the beach.

Cover up. One of the ways to protect your family from the sun is to cover up and shield skin from UV rays. Sunscreen should not be applied to babies under six months of age, so keep them out of the sun whenever possible.

Use sunscreen consistently. There are many good sunscreens available for kids. For children age six months and older, select an SPF of 15 or higher to prevent sunburn.

Use sunscreen whenever your child will be in the sun.

Apply sunscreen about 30 minutes before going outside so that a good layer of protection can form.

Do not try to stretch out a bottle of sunscreen, apply it generously.

Reapply sunscreen often, about every 2 to 3 hours, as recommended by the American Academy of Dermatology. Reapply after your child is sweating or swimming.

Apply a waterproof sunscreen if your child will be around water or swimming.
