

FIRE DEPARTMENT

One Hundred Years Later -
Still Going Strong!



On **Saturday, August 25**, the Riverdale Fire Department will host its **100th Anniversary Celebration**. The day will start at 12 noon on the Riverdale School front lawn with a memorial service for **Joe Ezzo**, who died on August 25, 1982 while responding to a fire. The Borough will dedicate a lamp post in front of the school in his honor.

Beginning at 4 pm a traditional wetdown will be held at the firehouse on Post Lane. Purchase a \$10 mug entitling you to food, refreshments and entertainment. Area fire departments will be on hand to help us celebrate.

At 7:30 pm the celebration moves to Freedom Park for the final night of the Summer Concert Series, performance by the Mahoney Brothers. Concluding the celebration will be a **fireworks display**. The final concert and fireworks are sponsored by **Target**.

All residents are urged to come out and show their support for our Fire Department on their monumental 100th Anniversary. We owe them, Riverdale's Bravest, our support. No better day than this!

The Riverdale Fire Department was awarded 2 grants to purchase equipment. One was from Prudential Financial in the amount of \$5,000, the second was from the Department of Homeland Security for \$39,778. This money will allow us replace 10 sets of turnout gear from 1994, and purchase an inflatable boat to be used for evacuations during a flood.
