

Newly appointed Police Captains **John Peine** & **Richard Roemmele** took their oaths of office.


### Riverdale going in the Green direction in 2008



## RIVERDALE SETS KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

The registration of children who will be attending Kindergarten at Riverdale School in September 2008 has been scheduled for Tuesday, February 5 and Thursday, February 7, 2008. Children whose last names begin with A-M will be registered between the hours of 9-12 noon on Tuesday, February 5<sup>th</sup> and N-Z from 9-12 noon on Thursday, February 7<sup>th</sup>.

To be eligible to attend school next September, a child must be five years of age on or before October 1, 2008. Parents must present an original birth certificate and medical records indicating the child has received four DPT Inoculations; the fourth inoculation must be given after the fourth birthday, five or more doses meet the requirement four doses of polio vaccine, two doses of mumps and rubella vaccine, varicella vaccine, and three doses Hepatitis B vaccine series.

Parent/guardian must present at least four (4) of the following documents as proof of residency at registration; utility bill, voting record, house deed, telephone bill, current department store or credit card bill, rent lease or contract.

## Helpful Health Hints - An Alternative View

**Ginkgo Biloba** is an herb with powerful antioxidant effects in the brain, retina and cardiovascular system. It is well known for its ability to enhance circulation, and a study reported in the *Journal of the American Medical Association* showed that it has a measurable effect on dementia in people with Alzheimer's disease and people recovering from strokes. Other studies indicate that it can improve both long- and short-term memory, and enhance concentration. Ginkgo Biloba has also been used to treat hearing problems, macular degeneration and may relieve leg cramps by improving circulation. Beneficial for asthma, depression, eczema, headaches, ringing in the ears, and heart and kidney disorders.
