



Fire Department

The Riverdale Fire Department is looking for members for its Junior Fire Department. High School students, ages 16 and 17, can join; they earn valuable credit for community service and based on their level of participation, can be eligible for up to \$200 annual clothing allowance, \$1,400 tax deferred LOSAP benefit and annual tuition credits at county college. If you join now, we could enroll you in this year's Junior Firefighter training class this summer. There are 2 classes July 8 - 30 or August 8 - 28. The classes are Mon - Fri, 8:00 AM - 4:00 PM. This class gives all the training needed to be a certified firefighter in NJ. You will receive your certification when you turn 18. Contact Chief Mike Norton at 973-831-1584.

- During the last month, the Fire Department was awarded 2 grants. The NJ Forest Fire Grant for \$4,112 and a grant from WalMart for \$1,000. The department applied for 9 grants in 2008 and was awarded 7 of them for a total of \$11,362! Great job!!



Dimethylsulfoxide - DMSO

DMSO is a by-product of wood processing for papermaking. It is a somewhat oily liquid that looks like mineral oil and has a slightly garlicky odor. Because it is an excellent solvent, it is widely used as a de-greaser, paint thinner and antifreeze. However, it also has remarkable therapeutic properties, especially for the healing of injuries. Applying DMSO on sprained ankles, pulled muscles, dislocated joints, and even at the site of simple fractures can virtually eliminate pain. It also promotes immune-system activity.

DMSO is absorbed through the skin and enters the bloodstream by osmosis through capillary walls. It is then distributed through the circulatory system and ultimately is excreted through the urine.
