**RESOLUTION REQUESTING PERMISSION FOR THE DEDICATION BY RIDER FOR
BOROUGH BEAUTIFICATION DONATIONS AS REQUIRED BY N.J.S.A. 40A:5-29**

WHEREAS, permission is required of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services for approval as a dedication by rider of revenues received by a municipality when the revenue is not subject to reasonably accurate estimates in advance; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:5-29 provides for receipt of funds from gifts, bequests, and donations by the municipality to provide for the operating costs to administer this act; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-39 provides the dedicated revenues anticipated from Borough Beautification Donations are hereby anticipated as revenue and are hereby appropriated for the purpose to which said revenue is dedicated by statute or other legal requirement:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Riverdale, County of Morris, and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Governing Body does hereby request permission of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to place gift funds received by the Borough of Riverdale for Borough Beautification Donations in a specified fund to be considered a dedication by rider to the budget in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:4-39 for Borough of Riverdale Borough Beautification Donations.
2. The Municipal Clerk of the Borough of Riverdale is hereby directed to forward two certified copies of this resolution to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
3. This resolution shall not become effective until this resolution is approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
