

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TAXES FOR THE YEAR 1923.

The Council of the Borough of Riverdale hereby ordains:

(1) That there be assessed and raised by taxation and collected for the year 1923, the sum of six hundred eighty-one Dollars and sixteen cents, for the purpose of meeting the appropriations set forth in the following statement of resources and appropriations for the year 1923.
