



## BOROUGH OF RIVERDALE ORDINANCE Chapter 85 – Dogs

Ordinance will be enforced



### Chapter 89-5 Dogs at large.

No person owning, keeping or harboring any dog, whether of licensing age or not, and whether licensed or not, shall suffer or permit such dog to run at large anywhere within the limits of the Borough of Riverdale. Any dog not secured by a leash, not confined or not under control of the owner, keeper or harbinger, shall be considered to have been suffered or permitted by its owner, keeper or harbinger to run at large and the owner, keeper or harbinger of such dog shall be prima facie guilty of a violation of this section. The provisions of this section shall not apply to any dogs running at large on the premises of the person owning, keeping or harboring any such dog, nor to running dogs while hunting or training for hunting.

### Chapter 89-7 Violations and penalties.

Any person found guilty of violating or failing to comply with any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 for each violation or imprisonment for a term not to exceed 90 days, or both.
