Chairman Millie Stires asked how many times the restaurants are inspected. Mr. Zachok explained the process. Vice-Chairman Dakake stated there was a few fires at Wes's Tavern. The building is going to be demolished the end of June.

Linda Roetman stated the new owners will be constructing the property exactly the way the board approved it with the two stores in the back, a restaurant in the front and eight apartments on the second floor.
