ORDINANCE NO. 07-2022

CAPITAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO WATER AND WASTEWATER INFRASTRUCTURE AS WELL AS SUPPORTING PUBLIC HEALTH EXPENDITURES IN THE BOROUGH OF RIVERDALE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING THEREFORE THE SUM OF \$432,804.46 FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN GRANT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Riverdale, in the County of Morris, New Jersey, that the following capital projects are hereby authorized to include the following improvements in water and wastewater infrastructure in the Borough of Riverdale:

1. Connecting existing sewer service area locations that cannot currently connect due to lack of piping including all tanks, pipes, lines, conduits, mains, equipment, pumps, and devices together with all site work, engineering, planning, attachments, accessories and equipment necessary therefor or incidental thereto.
2. Connecting sewer service expanded areas including all tanks, buildings, pipes, lines, conduits, mains, equipment, pumps, and devices together with all site work, engineering, planning, attachments, accessories and equipment necessary therefor or incidental thereto.
3. Connecting to or providing service for potable water service including all tanks, wells/source of supply, buildings, pipes, lines, conduits, mains, equipment, pumps, and devices together with all site work, engineering, planning, attachments, accessories and equipment necessary therefor or incidental thereto.
4. Supporting public health expenditures with respect to public communication efforts, enhancements to the design and execution of public health programs, and ventilation improvements in borough settings, health care settings, and other key locations, as well as capital investments in public facilities to meet pandemic operational needs.
5. Revenue replacement for the provision of government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue due to the COVID-19 public health emergency, relative to revenues collected in the most recent fiscal year prior to the emergency.

For a total Improvement Authorization of \$432,804.46

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the financing for the above projects be as follows:

American Rescue Plan Grant..... **\$432,804.46**

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the capital budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended capital budget and capital improvement program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, are on file with the Borough Clerk and are available for public inspection.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the period of usefulness of the capital projects are in excess of the five (5) year statutory requirement, and that no debt shall be incurred by the Borough for this authorization. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
