## ORDINANCE NO. 08-2020

### ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 47 ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT" OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RIVERDALE

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Riverdale, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** Chapter 47, Section 47-1 entitled "Department established; officers," of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Riverdale shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

**§ 47-1. Department established; officers.**

There is hereby established in the Borough of Riverdale a Police Department which shall consist of:

- One Chief
- Not more than two Lieutenants
- Not more than six Sergeants
- Not more than nine Patrolmen
- Not more than three Class II Specials

**Section 2.** If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

**Section 3.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
