ORDINANCE NO. 3-2017

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 160 "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RIVERDALE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Riverdale, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 160, "Vehicles and Traffic", Section 160-3, "Violations and penalties", of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Riverdale shall be amended to read as follows:

§ 160-3. Violations and penalties.

- A. Any person violating any parking restriction in this chapter, except handicapped parking, shall be subject to a fine of \$30.00 and costs of \$24.00.
- B. Any person convicted of a violation of handicapped parking restrictions shall be subject to a fine of \$250 for the first offense. For any subsequent violation of this subsection, a fine of at least \$250 and up to 90 days' community service or any combination thereof shall be imposed.
- C. Any person violating the truck route requirements (160-15) shall be subject to a fine of \$165.00 and costs of \$24.00.
- D. Any person violating the low speed vehicle on municipal streets prohibition shall be subject to a fine of \$30.00 and costs of \$24.00.
- E. Any person convicted of a violation of any other section of this chapter, unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey statute, shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$250.00 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 15 days, or both.

Section 2. Subsection 160-15(D) is hereby repealed

Section 3. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
