



## NEW OVERNIGHT PARKING RULES IN EFFECT FOR DECEMBER AND JANUARY



After several requests from residents, the Mayor and Council agreed to place a 2-month trial moratorium on overnight winter parking in the Borough of Riverdale.

### *WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?*

- You will be allowed to park your vehicle on permitted borough streets overnight as long as there is **NO SNOW** in the forecast. It is **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY** to monitor the weather.
- In the event that snow begins to fall and accumulate overnight, you will be subjected to Ordinance 160-26 prohibiting parking on snow covered streets.
- **DO NOT** take any chances if the weather is questionable. If it snows in the middle of the night and your vehicle is on the street, **YOU WILL RECEIVE A TICKET**. No warnings will be issued.
- If residents cooperate and the trial period is successful, the Mayor and Council will consider extending the moratorium for the entire season. Let's make this successful.

### **Ordinance: 160-26 Designation of snow emergency no-parking areas.**

- A. Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the street or highway, no vehicle shall be parked on either side of any of the streets or highways in the Borough. This prohibition shall not apply to state and county roads.
- B. The above parking prohibitions shall remain in effect after the snow has ceased until the streets have been plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will not interfere with the normal flow of traffic.
